David R. Dow is a professor of law at the University of Houston. He earned his B.A. *magna cum laude* from Rice University, and his M.A. (in history) and J.D. from Yale University, where he was an editor on the *Yale Law Journal*. Upon graduation, he clerked for Judge Carolyn Dineen King of the United States Court of Appeals for the Fifth Circuit, and subsequently practiced law at the firm of Susman Godfrey L.L.P., where he specialized in commercial litigation.

Mr. Dow now specializes in appeals and dispositive motions and has handled in excess of fifty appeals in numerous state courts of appeals, the Texas Supreme Court, and the Texas Court of Criminal Appeals, as well as the federal courts of appeals, including the Fifth Circuit, and the Supreme Court of the United States. He joined the University of Houston faculty in 1988, was awarded tenure in 1991, and was promoted to full professor in 1995. He teaches and publishes in the areas of contracts, federal courts, constitutional law, and death penalty law. His book *Machinery of Death* was published in 2002. This month Thomson/West published "*Contract Law*" by Professor David R. Dow and Craig Smyser, Volume 49 in the West Texas Practice Series.
